

GCSE Results Day

Dear Student,

I wanted to let you know the provisional plans for Results Day that have been drawn up, naturally these plans may change if government guidance changes or we have to re-enter a lockdown, be that regional or national.

Your GCSE results are available on **Thursday 20th August 2020**. There are four ways you can receive them:

Option 1 – Collection from School

You can collect your results face to face in school on results day. Time slots have been allocated by Maths classes and you should arrive within your allocated slot.

Due to the current circumstances surrounding COVID-19 there will be several measures in place to ensure social distancing and hygiene regulations are adhered to;

- Arrive on site through the gate by the red M at the front of school.
- If you arrive by car then parents/guardians/siblings/friends must stay in the car at all times.
- At the front of school by the main entrance there will be a queue for each Maths class. Please join the correct queue and stand on a coloured dot.
- You will be guided to the main hall by a member of staff to collect your results. Please adhere to social distance guidelines at all times.
- Before entering the building there will be hand-sanitising station where you will clean your hands.
- On entering the hall you will be guided to the collection table, here you will sign for your results and be given your results
- Students who need to discuss their 6th form place will be directed to the Library by staff to meet with the 6th form team.
- Students who are not wanting to meet the 6th form team will be directed to the exit outside the doors to the rear of the canteen where you will leave site.

Option 2 - Telephone

You can call the main school line **after 8.30am** on 01691 664400. A password must be agreed with Mrs Gibson the Exams Officer via email **before** results day. Mrs Gibson's email is gibson.r@mmat.co.uk you will need to quote this password before any results will be released over the phone.

Option 3 – Emailed to your school account

You can have your results sent by email to your MMAT email account this will need to be requested by emailing Mrs Gibson from your MMAT account **before** results day. The results are yours and therefore **cannot** be given or emailed to any other person.

Option 4 - Posted

Results not collected on Thursday 20th August will be posted, first class, to the address we have on the database for the student unless notified otherwise.

Due to the current circumstances surrounding COVID-19 there will be several measures in place to ensure social distancing and hygiene regulations are adhered to;

- Parents/siblings/friends will NOT be allowed to accompany the students onto the site to avoid large gatherings
- You will be guided to the main hall by a member of staff following the social distance markers on the ground.
- 2 queues will be formed and indicated by your classes on laminated signs held by staff members
- You will need to wash your hands before entering the building
- On entering the hall you will be guided to the collection table, where you will sign for your results and be given your results
- Students who need to discuss their 6th form place you will be directed to either; queuing outside the LRC to meet with the 6th form team in the LRC and MFL block. You will need to wash your hands before entering the building
- Students who are not wanting to meet the 6th form team will be directed to the exit outside the doors to the rear of the canteen and you will need to wash your hands before exiting the building
